

Washington West Supervisory Union Model Policy

Policy E11

E11: RELATING TO THE IDLING OF VEHICLES OTHER THAN SCHOOL BUSES WHEN PRESENT ON SCHOOL PREMISES

Applicability:

This policy applies to all motor vehicles, other than school buses, while on school grounds. School buses are addressed in proposed Rule 6001.

It is the intent of the school boards of the following member district schools of the Washington West Supervisory Union: Fayston Elementary School, Moretown Elementary School, Waitsfield Elementary School, Warren Elementary School, and the Waterbury/Duxbury Union School District (Crossett Brook Middle School and Thatcher Brook Primary School) to also limit the idling of motor vehicles other than school buses in school grounds according to established procedures.

Definition:

As used in this policy, the term “school grounds” shall mean any area adjacent to school buildings and used at any time for school related activities, including parking lots, playing fields and driveways.

Policy:

Subject to exceptions developed by a principal, the operators of motor vehicles, other than school buses, will limit the idling of their vehicles to the greatest extent possible while on school grounds.
